We comply with the rules of ethics accepted by the associations of the security branch (TAF) and code of ethics and professional standards of IKD (International Komission der Detektiv-Verbände).

The association has representatives in the advisory board of the Security branch.

Solid professional skills are required of the members in order to operate as professional

detectives. Approximately 16 members representing different offices belong to the organisation.

Association Activities:

The association maintains the professional skills of its members by arranging educational meetings, fieldtrips and tours and by following the international and domestic development of the security branch and especially the private investigation.

The association strives to take care of the promotion of interests and briefing of its members regarding the authorities. The member offices are specialized in various branches and accept assignments according to their fields of expertise. When needed for investigations, experts of special skills are being used, such as specialists in medicine, computing technology, access control, graphology etc.
