BuDEG is co-initiator of the German quality standard DIN SPEC 33452:2017 "Code of practice for the provision of commercial private investigative services". In the long term, BuDEG aims to achieve government regulation on this basis.

BuDEG has had cooperated in established ISO TS 37008. ISO/TS 37008:2023 is a technical standard developed by the International Organisation for Standardisation (ISO) to provide guidance and recommendations for internal investigations in organisations. This ISO is a document on compliance issues and provides standards for internal investigations.
